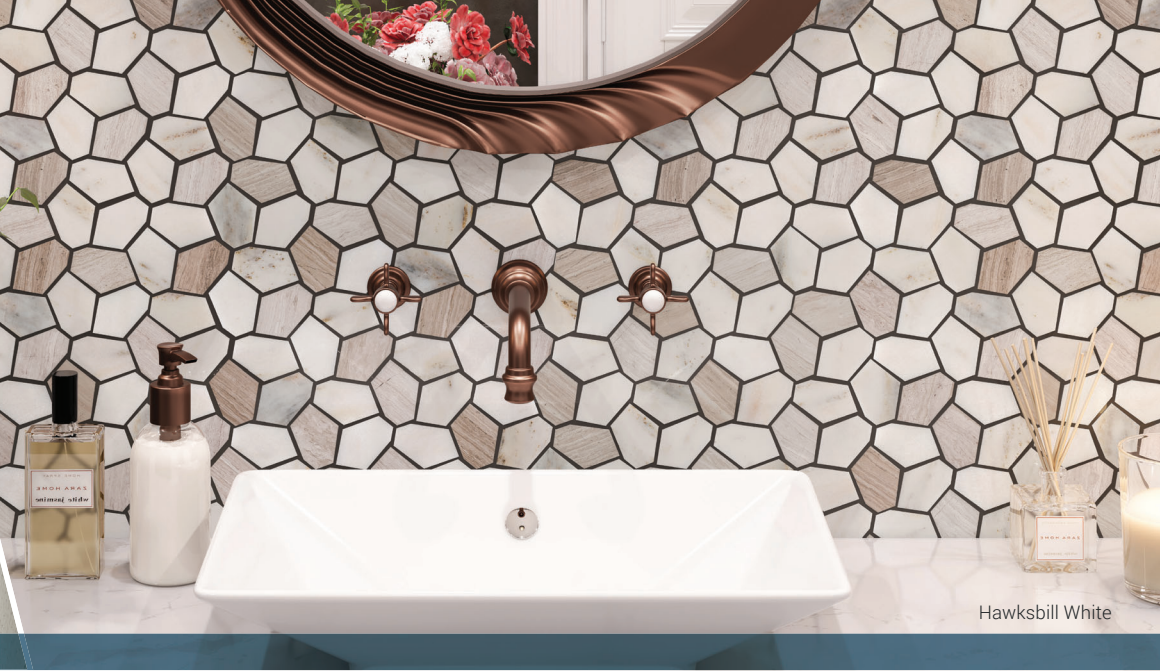

*River Rock mosaics are unique pebbles of irregular shapes, sizes, and textures. These natural imperfections create installation challenges of uneven textures and product spacing that need to be addressed during installation. Extra care must be taken to create a more even installation. Once set into appropriate mortar, one should apply pressure to mosaic sheets using a grout float or wood block and rubber mallet to flatten higher pieces. Pebbles can vary in size and shape creating some noticeable "picture framing" of various sheets that will need to be addressed. It is a common practice to remove certain pebbles from the mesh backing and reorganize them to fill in some of the larger voids. All material should be inspected before installation. Any questions as to the suitability of the product for its intended application must be resolved before installation. Use constitutes acceptance.

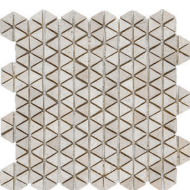

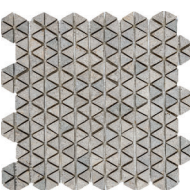

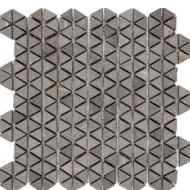
